The main aim of Álvaro Torrente's project, *DIDONE. The Sources of Absolute Music: Mapping Emotions in Eighteenth-Century Italian opera*, is the creation of a corpus consisting of 4,000 arias based on Metastasio's most popular dramas.

Contract duration: 11 months, starting on February 1, 2019, extendable annually until December 31, 2023.

Requirements:

- Doctor's degree, preferably in Music, musicology or related areas.
- Languages: English (level B2 or equivalent), Spanish (B1 or equivalent).
- Knowledge of musical analysis at the Higher Music Degree level.
- Knowledge of music editing software.

The following will also be assessed:

- Research experience with testable results in musical theatre and/or eighteenth-century music.
- Experience in the development of musical and / or textual analysis methodologies.
- Basic knowledge of Italian and / or German.
- Experience in music archival research.
- Ability to work in multidisciplinary teams.
- Knowledge of the music editing software Finale.
- Experience in computer application in musicology.

Tasks:

- Location and digitalization of musical sources.
- Development of models of comparative analysis of opera arias.
- Review and correction of musical editions of opera arias. - Writing of scientific articles in collaboration with the IP.

The preselected candidates will be interviewed from January 21 to 23, 2019. If there is more than one candidate who meets the requirements, an employment pool can be created for future calls for postdoctoral contracts.
